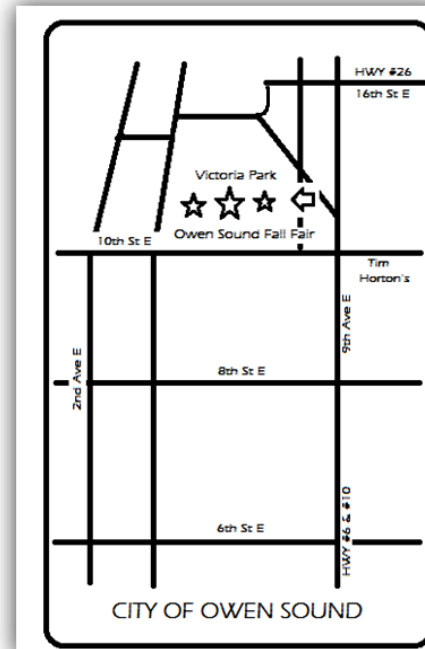

GENERAL RULES

1. Please read rules and size requirements very carefully to avoid disqualifications.
2. Some part of the entry must have been made by the exhibitor; either top or quilting or both.
3. All entries must be completely finished, clean and in good condition.
4. Preprinted panels will NOT be accepted unless cut and used creatively in your quilt.
5. Entrants are responsible for ensuring that quilts are entered in **correct category.**
6. Competitors may submit only one entry per Category.
7. Work of one or more individuals is eligible and must be indicated on entry form.
8. Send entry form (no photo required) and cheque, amount payable in Canadian funds to:

9. Entries from a distance may be sent to a Quilt Committee Member. Submissions sent must be insured and include instructions for return, along with funds to cover the postage and insurance. No C.O.D. Canadian currency.
10. Entries must be picked up at the Quilt Show location on Sunday, September 10, 2017 from 10:45 a.m.-11:30 a.m., unless other arrangements are made.
11. All entries are to be insured by participant from the time of drop-off until time of pickup by entrant's home insurance policy.
12. Previous entries of the "Fruits of Our Labour" Quilt Show are not eligible.

CHECKLIST

- Does quilted item still fit criteria of category regarding size, content, etc.?** If not, contact co-ordinator prior to delivery.
- Does it have a 4" sleeve for hanging, (Including Wallhangings)**
- Have you covered your label?**
- Are your quilts in separate cloth bags?**

PLEASE NOTE: Entries are to be delivered or sent to a member of the committee by Sept. 2nd, 2017 ready for judging. Prizes may be cash, gift certificates or merchandise and must be accepted as awarded.

CATEGORIES

ENTRY FEE IS \$6.00 FOR EACH ENTRY

CATEGORY #1 Large Quilt Pieced

This quilt may be pieced by any method but must be hand quilted.

Total Perimeter of Finished Quilt 324" Minimum
Prizes: 1st \$250. 2nd \$150. 3rd \$75. 4th \$25.

CATEGORY #2 Large Quilt Appliqued

This quilt may be appliquéd by hand or machine and must be hand quilted.

Total Perimeter of Finished Quilt 324" Minimum
Prizes: 1st \$250. 2nd \$150. 3rd \$75. 4th \$25.

CATEGORY #3 Large Quilt Industrial Long Arm

This quilt can be created using any technique but must be quilted by an industrial long arm quilting machine.

Total Perimeter of Finished Quilt 324" Minimum
Prizes: 1st \$250. 2nd \$150. 3rd \$75. 4th \$25.

CATEGORY #4 Large Quilt - Domestic Machine

This quilt can be created using any technique but must be quilted on a domestic machine.

Total Perimeter of Finished Quilt 324" Minimum
Prizes: 1st \$250. 2nd \$150. 3rd \$75. 4th \$25.

CATEGORY #5 Single Bed Quilt or Lap Quilt

Any technique is acceptable, but must include quilting.

Total Perimeter of Finished Quilt 210" to 324"
Prizes: 1st \$250. 2nd \$150. 3rd \$75. 4th \$25.

CATEGORY #6 Crib or Toddler Bed Quilt

Any technique is acceptable, but must include quilting.

Must be suitable for a child, under 4 years old.
Total Perimeter of Finished Quilt 150" to 210"
Prizes: 1st \$250. 2nd \$150. 3rd \$75. 4th \$25.

CATEGORY #7 Wallhanging

Theme: `Canada – Our Home and Native Land`
Any technique is acceptable, but must include quilting.

Total Perimeter of Finished Wallhanging 72" to 192"
Prizes: 1st \$250. 2nd \$150. 3rd \$75. 4th \$25.
